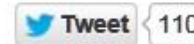

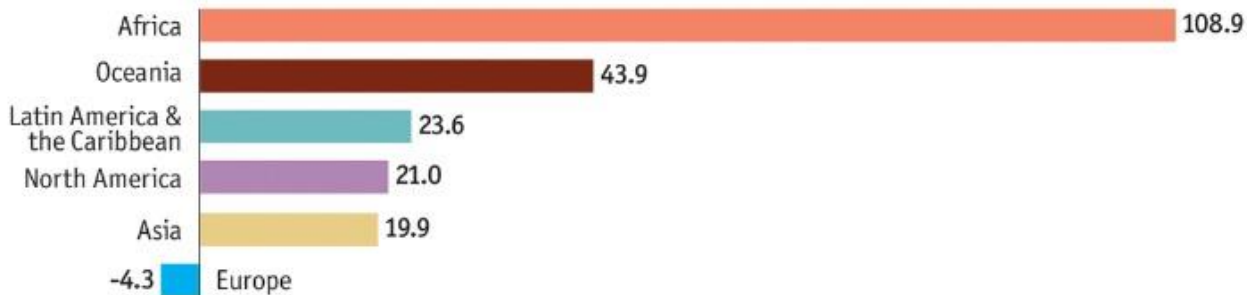
Global population forecasts

2015



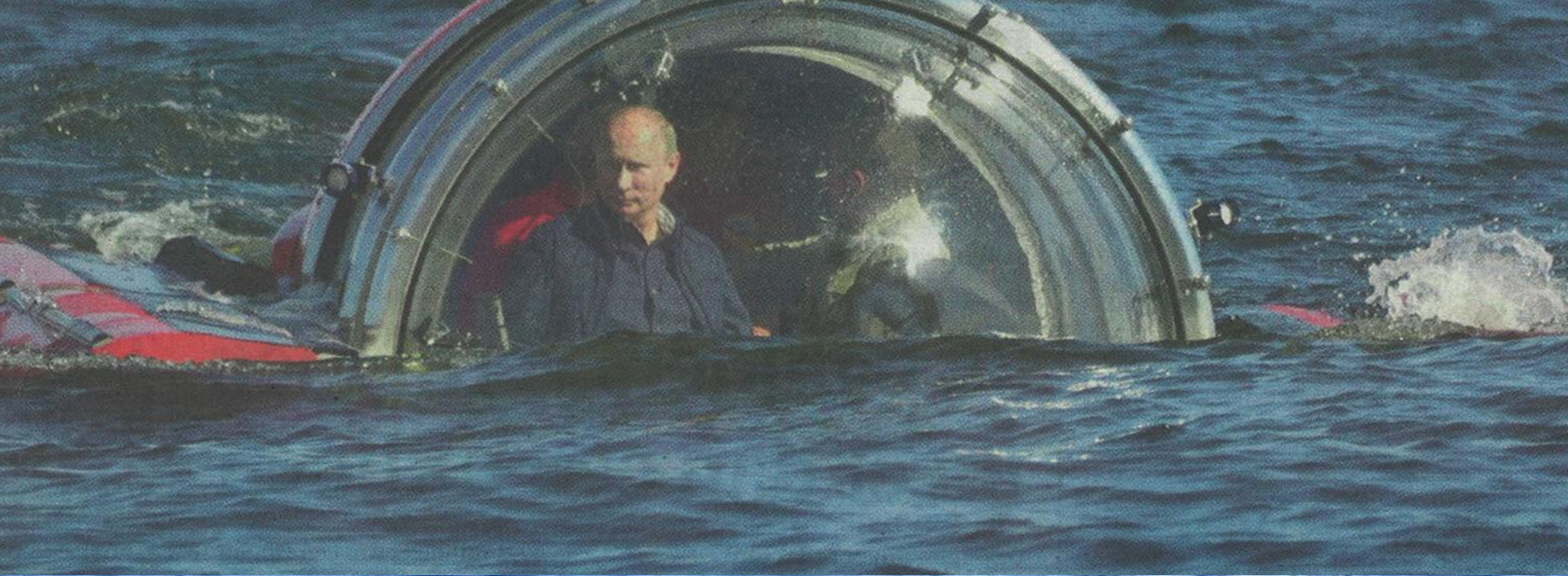
2050 forecast



2100 forecast

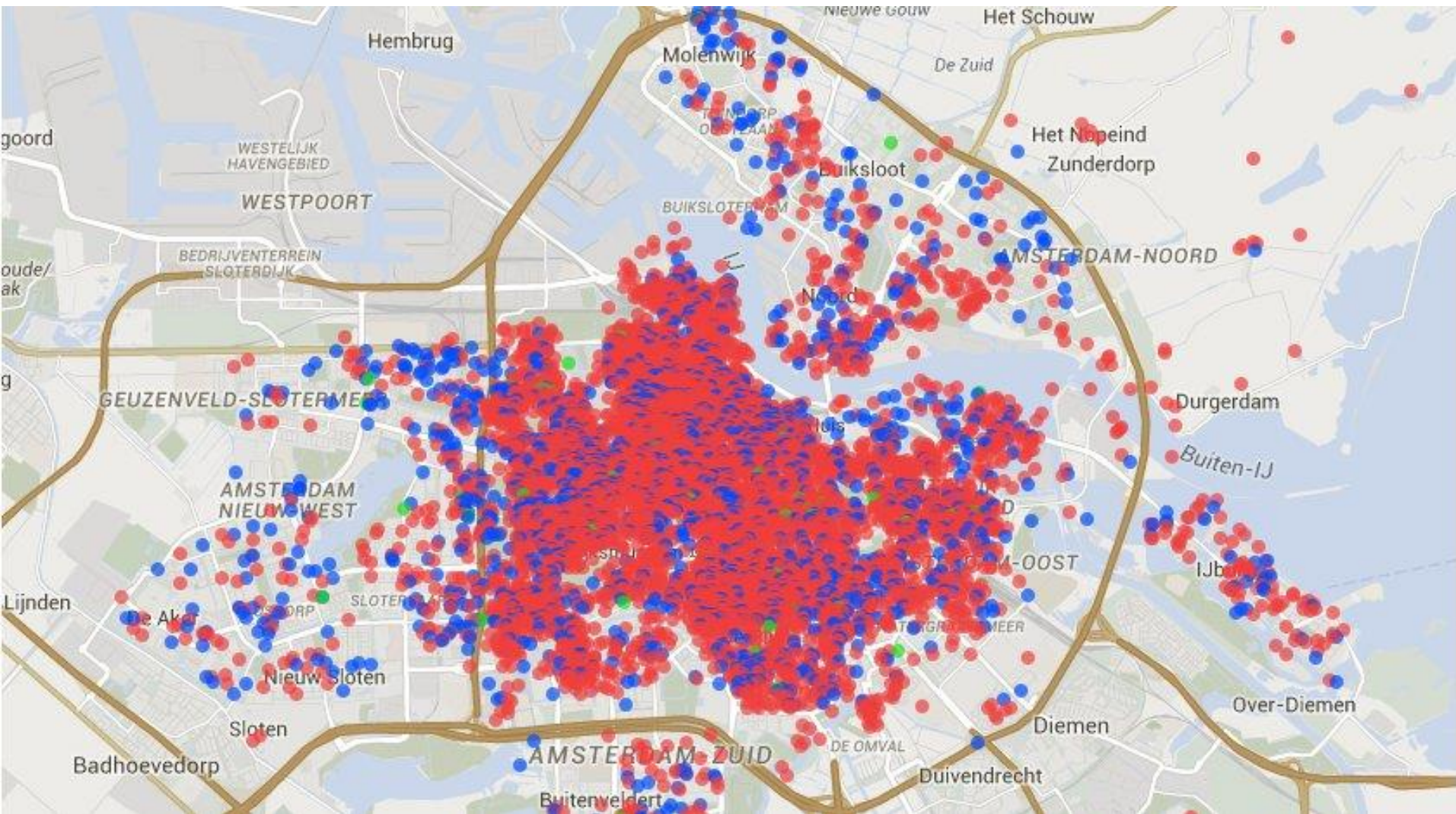

STEREOTYPES OF THE NETHERLANDS



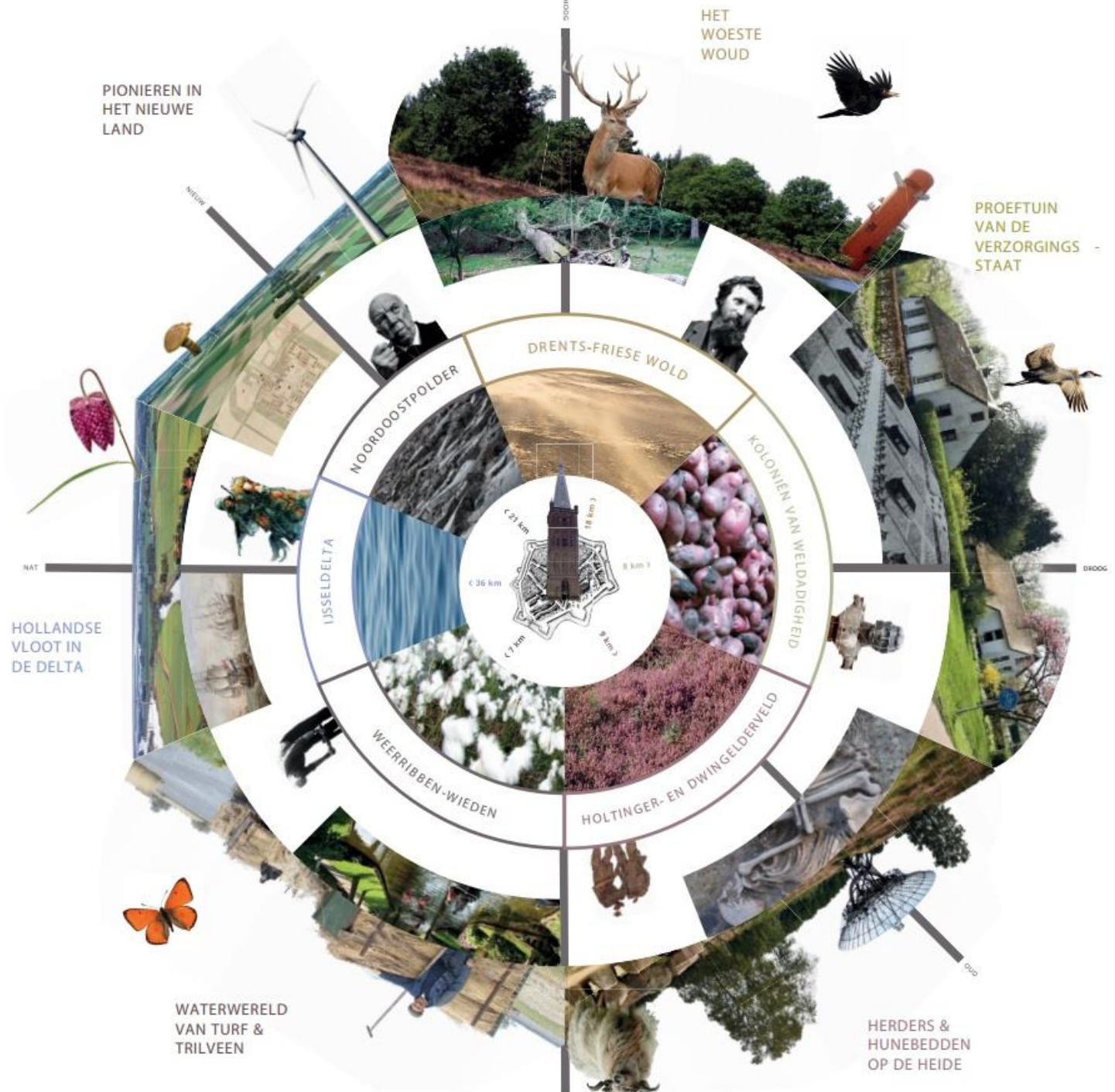

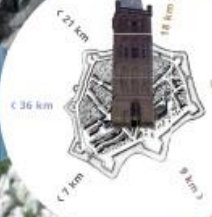
